Our pastor and church Organist have the right of first refusal. If another Pastor and/or church Organist is invited to perform the ceremony, it must be done in consultation with, and by permission of the Pastor and/or Organist.

Agreement:

1. All fees are payable prior to the wedding rehearsal.
2. All flowers (except those donated to the church), flower boxes, flower petals, wedding bulletins, wax drippings, or other items must be removed from the church following the ceremony.
3. Rice and confetti are not allowed. Birdseed is allowed outside the building, not inside, and must be swept from the stairs and walkways.
4. With the exception of professional photographers, usage of flash photography is not permitted during the wedding ceremony. A photo opportunity may be planned following the ceremony.
5. Professional photographers and videographers will need to consult with the Pastor prior to the ceremony as to acceptable protocol.
6. Smoking is not allowed. We are a smoke-free facility.
7. The wedding party will be liable and may be billed for any damage to the building or property that occurs as a result of this event.
8. Rental of the sanctuary does not include use of our upstairs kitchen area, or use of the downstairs fellowship hall.
